Mock trial teams will learn their Regional Competition site assignment within 10 days of this deadline. All teams will be assigned based on their list of preferences and space availability.

Saturday, February 20, 2010

Regional Competition

Mock trial teams compete at six regional sites throughout North Carolina (**Asheville, Charlotte, Durham, Fayetteville, High Point, Wilmington**). Teams at all sites will compete in two rounds of competition, while the two top-ranking teams will play a third and final round. All teams will have an opportunity to try both sides of the case. Registration begins at 9 am and students should plan to spend the day at the courthouse—the final round will end at approximately 6 pm.

Saturday, March 19&20, 2010

State Finals Competition

Six regional winners and two additional qualifying teams will meet in Raleigh to compete for the title of State Champion.
